



NOTE ON CONSTRUCTION OF MAP.
 The principal point of which the latitude has been determined is Barkerville. The longitude depends on the connection of the same place by steel traverses along the wagon road to Lake La Hache & vicinal surveys thence to Ashcroft on the C. P. Railway the position of which has been accurately determined trigonometrically by the Dominion Lands Branch. The geographical position here has been fixed by triangulation starting from a base measured on Shoshone Plains, the triangulation being locked on a second base at Quenel's Mouth. Principal stations occupied—Gray Mts., Quenel Forks Mt., Bulger Peak, Round Top, Green Ch. Mt., Barkerville Mts., M. Mitchell, Cariboo Mts., Yanks Peak, Palomares Mts., the Two Sisters, M. Wiley, M. Ames, D. Anderson and Dragon Mt.—A. Bowman and J. McEvoy. Valley details by what remains of trails, by J. McEvoy, S. P. Park, C. E. and L. R. Volpog, C. E.
